The Session of Westminster has called for a special congregational meeting, Sunday, December 15, 2024, immediately following worship in the sanctuary to vote on their recommendation to call Junha Kim as an associate pastor. The motion includes terms of call.

Motion: The Session moves that Westminster Presbyterian Church elect Junha Kim as Associate Pastor for Youth, Mission, and Community Engagement pending successful examination by the Presbytery of the Cascades with the following terms of call:

Junha has been serving Westminster since August 15, 2024, as the Director of Youth, Mission, and Community Engagement. Junha (who likes to be called Jun, pronounced June) was born in South Korea and grew up in Los Angeles, where his father is a PC(USA) pastor. Junha graduated from University of California – Berkeley and received his master's in divinity from Vanderbilt Divinity School.

Since graduating from Vanderbilt, Junha has worked as a youth director at two Bay Area congregations. He is currently pursuing a Ph.D. at the Graduate Theological Union in the Bay Area, and his scholarly work is in the areas of theology and ethics.
